310 Permit

54-18-2022: Michael Keast- Clark Fork River- Site assessment completed, Follow-up to violation 2021.Site inspections were conducted on May 17th at 4pm. Site Inspections (Forms 272) were submitted to the Administrator by the following Supervisors: Joe Spangler, Joe Hughes and Ladd Knotek FWP. Follow-up forms for violation 54-10-2021 were submitted to Admin by Joe Spangler, Joe Hughes and Ladd Knotek FWP. The Landlord appeared to follow conditions of the Violation 310 permit.

Recommended landowner is in compliance and to close the application. Application 54-18-2022 was approved with modifications- **NO OTHER WORK OR DISTURBANCE IN ANY OTHER AREA SHOULD BE APPROVED;WORK/STABILIZATION ONLY AUTHORIZED ON THE UPPER PORTION OF EXISTING STAIRWAY PERTAINING TO RETAINING WALL.** Motion to approve 310 Permit (Form 273) by Joe Spangler, seconded by Joe Huges. Motion Passes. **Vote 6-0**

54-20-2022: Glenn Jones- Clark Fork River- Violation Site assessment completed, awaiting remediation 310 application- Discussion- Landowner must remediate and bring forward 310 application (form 270) for remediation plan at next meeting. The \$250.00 fine could be used towards the remediation cost. Board requests presence of the landowner and plan, on June 21st CD meeting. Land owner could not attend the June 1 meeting due to Hospital appointments. **Tabled**

54-21-2022: Glenn Jones-Clark Fork River- 310 Application Site assessment completed. Site inspections were conducted on May 17th at 4pm. Site Inspections (Forms 272) were submitted to the Administrator by the following Supervisors: Joe Spangler, Joe Hughes and Ladd Knotek FWP. Discussion- Proposed construction is right to the river bank, Land owner should be advised to coordinate with county and city planning with a setback that protects the river bank and minimize impact to the river. Advise landowner to submit another 310 application if runoff is NOT diverted to the street side. Motion by Joe H. to Approve 310 Permit (form 273) AS Not a Project; Out of Jurisdiction, Second by Joe S. Motion Passes. **Vote 6-0**
